Wehrle Gallery Exhibition Opening



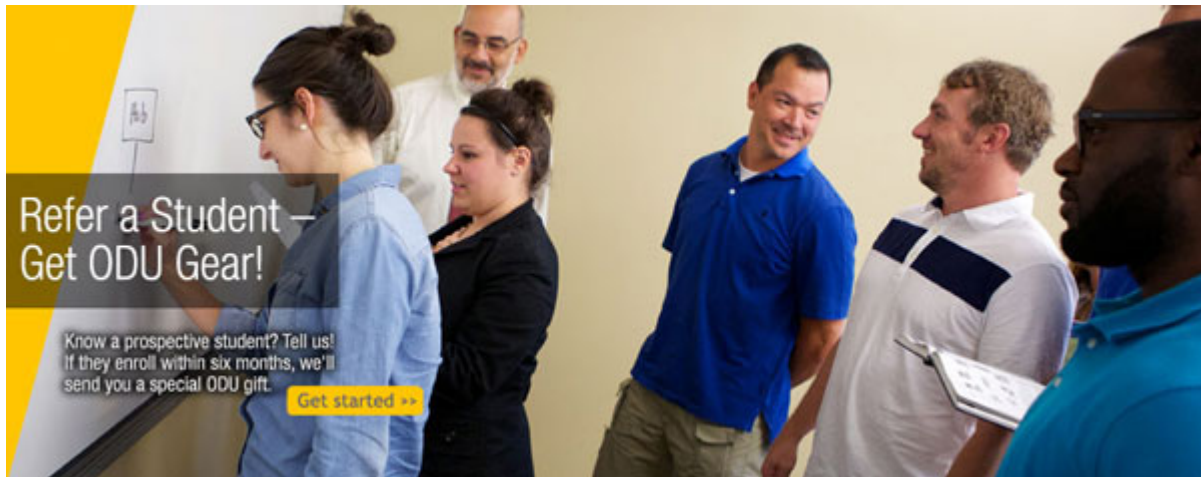
