This Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP) Appeal Application is designed for students whose aid has been suspended due to a deficiency of Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP) in an effort to regain eligibility for federal, state, and institutional financial aid. The Financial Aid Office at Ohio Dominican University reviews a student's entire academic history to ensure timely progression toward graduation. A student may only have two appeals during their academic career at ODU. Appeals with appropriate documentation will be reviewed by the SAP Review Committee; students will be notified of the decision, in writing, within 2-3 weeks. **All decisions of the Committee are final.**

Instructions:

1. Complete the 2012-2013 SAP Appeal Application.
2. Attach all documentation which clarifies/supports this appeal *by the specified deadline in your SAP Suspension Letter*. Appeals received after the deadline will not be considered.
3. Be specific when explaining the circumstances. Lack of information or documentation will result in a delay of an appeal review or may result in a denial of your appeal.
4. The SAP Review Committee presumes that each student appealing is dependent upon financial aid for the completion of his/her degree. Do not discuss the need for financial aid in your appeal.
