Football jumps to top 11 in AFCA poll

Ohio Dominican's undefeated football team is ranked second in the first regional rankings, which the NCAA released on Oct 28. This is the first time the football team has appeared in the regional rankings since becoming an active Division II member and being eligible for postseason play in 2011. The Panthers trail just Colorado State-Pueblo in the rankings.

As members of the GLIAC, the Panthers belong in Super Region Four, along with the Great Lakes Valley Conference (GLVC), Lone Star Conference (LSC) and Rocky Mountain Athletic Conference (RMAC). Six teams from each of the four regions qualify for the playoffs, with the top two seeds in each region earning a first round bye.

The schedule for playoff games:

Nov. 23 – First Round
Nov. 30 – Second Round
Dec. 7 – Quarterfinals
Dec. 14 – Semifinals
Dec. 21 – Championship Game, to be played at Braly Municipal Stadium in Florence, Ala.

Men's Soccer Comes Home as GLIAC Regular Season Co-Champions



After battling to a 2-2 double overtime draw at Walsh on Sunday Nov. 2, and riding a regular season 10-game unbeaten streak, the Ohio Dominican men's soccer team returned to Columbus as the Great Lakes Intercollegiate Athletic Conference Co-Champions.

It's the first conference championship - either regular season or tournament - for any program at Ohio

Dominican since joining the GLIAC in 2010.

The Panthers' 10 game unbeaten streak started back on Sept. 29. ODU finished the regular season with a 10-2-4 overall record and 9-2-3 mark in the conference.

With the win, the Panthers secured the top seed for the GLIAC Tournament after winning the tie breaker over co-champion Tiffin.

ODU defeated the Dragons at Tiffin earlier this year and tied them at Panther Field. ODU is guaranteed a first round bye and a trip to the GLIAC final four on Friday, Nov. 8.
