



## Project JumpStart | Dual Enrollment Program

### Bishop Watterson High School students, are you ready to . . .

- Earn both college and high school credit?
- Begin your college education at a fraction of the cost?
- Use your earned credit at Ohio Dominican University or another institution?

Project JumpStart gives academically advanced high school students the opportunity to earn college credit while remaining in the high school classroom. To qualify, you must have a minimum 3.0 GPA or at least a 2.75 GPA and an ACT score of 20 or higher, as well as parent permission.

- **FIN 110 Personal Finance (3)** with Ms. Cook

- **SPN 215 Intermediate Spanish Composition & Conversation (3)** with Ms. Summanen

(3 credit hour courses are \$195 each)
