Academic Tutoring

Learning Strategy & ACE Content Tutoring (Spangler 207)

ACE tutors help students understand faculty expectations so they can identify and focus on key concepts in a new and unfamiliar discipline, practice organizing information, and spend study time more effectively. ACE tutors each have a content specialization as well as general learning strategy expertise. Students may drop in (the schedule is posted online) or make an appointment using Tutor Trac (also online at www.ohiodominican.edu/arc/ace).

The Math Lab (Spangler 206A)

The Math Lab offers drop-in hours for assistance in most ODU math courses, as well as support in the quantitative aspects of introductory STEM and business courses.

See the online schedule for tutor specializations; while all math tutors can help with basic math, senior tutors should be seen for statistics and calculus.

Review and Process (R.A.P)

For selected courses identified as historically difficult, the ARC provides leaders for regularly scheduled, group study sessions. RAP leaders work closely with faculty in particular courses to help students prepare for and process challenging material.

R.A.P. sessions move at the pace of the class; students who need “catch up” should schedule individual tutoring appointments. We can also provide tutors to assist student-formed groups for non-RAP courses – students need only make a request!

Test Preparation

The ARC provides materials and instruction to help students prepare for standardized tests such as the Praxis Core, OAE, GRE, and MCAT.

The Write Place (Spangler 206B)

Peer writing tutors are available by appointment or on a walk-in basis to assist students in all aspects of the writing process. Writing tutoring involves collaboration between the tutor and the student; there is no drop-off editing service. The policy of the Write Place is “pen off paper” – we work with students so that they are able to improve as writers; all writing is done by the student.
