HOW TO GET THE MOST FROM THE MATH LAB:

Review notes and textbook for vocabulary and formulas before going to the lab.

Try all problems on your own. Be persistent, but if you can't find a solution after 10 minutes and you're frustrated, skip the problem and come back to it later, or seek help.

Ask specific questions. Don't say "I don't get Chapter 3." Say, "I was solving this equation and I did the first two steps, but then I don't know what to do with the x ."

Bring any work you've done with you. The tutor will be able to see exactly where you got stuck, so your session will be **more efficient**.

The Math Lab will not do homework for you. Expect tutors to ask you leading questions to help you arrive at the correct answer yourself.

The goal of tutoring is to help students become independent, resourceful learners.

TIPS FOR MATH SUCCESS:

Use the time before class starts to **review**: look over vocabulary and problems from last class.

Take good notes. Write down more than what is on the board. Anything the instructor says more than once is *really* important, so write it down.

Read the textbook to get the complete picture. Work out examples and checkpoint problems.

Do all assigned problems. The problem you skip just might be on the test! Sometimes, you might need to do extra (unassigned) problems to gain full understanding.

Ask questions in class. Other students have the same question.

Practice, practice, practice! Math is not a spectator sport! Practice makes progress!

Keep up with concepts and assignments. Math builds on itself. **Work on math a little bit every day, reviewing past concepts frequently.**

Make sure your answer is **reasonable** and makes sense. When possible, check your answer.

Keep a positive attitude, and expect to be challenged.
