# What is Dual Enrollment?

- You are both a high school student and a Ohio Dominican University college student earning college transcribed credit for the courses offered at your high school.
- The college courses will count toward your high school degree and they also count toward an Associate's degree or a Bachelor's degree.
- Your ODU college courses will be completed at your high school with your high school instructor who is also an ODU Adjunct Instructor.

# What are the benefits of Dual Enrollment?

- It saves you time and money by taking the college courses at your high school for college credit. Explore academic interests with low risk.
- Receive Ohio Dominican Services:
- Free access to library databases
- Access to an advisor
- Online tutoring is available
- Free access to Fitness Center, campus events, guest speakers and more!

# Dual Enrollment Course Tuition

## **Private High School Students:**

\$65.00 per credit hour. A three credit course is  $(3 \times \$65.00 = \$195.00)$

$(4 \text{ credits} \times \$65.00 = \$260.00)$

## **Public High School Students:**

\$75.00 per credit hour. A three credit hour course is  $(3 \times \$75.00 = \$225.00)$

$(4 \text{ credits} \times \$75.00 = \$300)$ .

# Transferring Your ODU Course Credits

- Ohio Dominican course credits will transfer to most public and private universities as long as you earn a final grade of “C” or higher in the course.
- Courses fulfill most general education or elective requirements for an Associate’s or Bachelor’s degree!



# Dual Enrollment Admission Criteria

## Student Criteria

- You need an overall GPA of 3.0
- OR at least a 2.75 GPA and an ACT score of 20 or SAT score of 1440.

# Dual Enrollment Registration

- For **Fall or Full Year** courses, complete the online registration form at [http://www.ohiodominican.edu/Project\\_JumpStart/](http://www.ohiodominican.edu/Project_JumpStart/) and ask your high school counselor to send your high school transcript to ODU by **September 17, 2014**. (***Spring Course Registration will be available in November***).
- Submit payment to ODU by **October 10, 2014**. Payment can be done by check or call ODU's Business Office to pay by credit card: 614.251.4550.
